FOOD AND WATER

- ☐ A 3–7 day supply of your dog’s regular food, stored in airtight, waterproof containers
- ☐ Collapsible or travel-safe bowls
- ☐ Bottled water (enough for several days)
- ☐ Feeding schedule instructions

IDENTIFICATION AND LEASHES

- ☐ A secure collar with an up-to-date ID tag
- ☐ A sturdy leash and back-up harness
- ☐ Recent printed photos of your dog in case of separation
- ☐ Microchip registration information

OPTIONAL ADDITIONS

- ☐ Paw protectors or booties, especially for extreme weather
- ☐ Calming chews or vet-approved anxiety aids
- ☐ A backup power bank for smart collars or pet GPS devices
- ☐ A copy of your emergency evacuation plan with dog-friendly shelter options listed

MEDICATIONS AND MEDICAL RECORDS

- ☐ A full supply of any daily medications or supplements
- ☐ A printed copy of veterinary records, vaccination history, and microchip details
- ☐ Emergency contact numbers for your veterinarian and a nearby emergency clinic
- ☐ Basic first-aid supplies, including bandages, antiseptic wipes, tweezers, and tick removers

COMFORT AND CONTAINMENT

- ☐ A familiar blanket or towel with your scent
- ☐ A favorite toy to reduce stress
- ☐ A portable crate or travel carrier

SANITATION SUPPLIES

- ☐ Waste bags
- ☐ Puppy pads or towels
- ☐ Dog-safe disinfectant wipes
- A spare set of grooming essentials if needed
